1 amputation every 40 hours







In 2018, 99,000 people in Saskatchewan are living with diabetes



1,100 to 1,900 will have a diabetic foot ulcer



Nearly **217** will have an amputation below the knee



Direct health-care costs:

Up to \$27 million a year







What can we do? In addition to improved screening and foot care, increased government funding for specialized devices can help prevent amputations and save our health-care system up to \$7.3 million a year.
